- 2 Exhibitors entry cards must be firmly attached to exhibits, BEFORE bringing to the show. In the case of cookery classes, entry cards should be attached to the plate and not to cling film. If possible use cellophane food bags but in any case please cover your exhibits.
- 3 Artists names must be concealed on drawings and paintings.
- 4 Exhibitors may show a Maximum of 4 exhibits in any one class but may enter any number of classes
- 5 All classes are **OPEN** unless otherwise stated
- 6 Please do not exhibit an item which has previously won a prize in the Handicraft section
- 7 All exhibits must be brought to the marquee between 7.30am and 9.30am on show day. Exhibits may not be removed until after Prize Giving (*see main programme for times*)
- 8 Any complaint, regarding exhibits to be made to the Handicraft Secretary in writing, by 4pm on show day.

- Prize money will be awarded to children's classes only. 1st £1, 2nd 80p, 3rd 60p. Highly Commended 50p.
