RECIPES

FRUIT CAKE (7" approx.) **

8oz Self Raising Flour, ¼ teaspoon salt, 4oz Margarine, 4oz Caster Sugar, 2 Eggs, 9oz Mixed Fruit, e.g., Currants, Sultanas, Peel, Cherries etc. a little grated orange rind, eighth of a pint of milk

METHOD:

Sieve flour and salt. Beat the margarine until soft, add sugar and cream together until the mixture is light in colour and fluffy in texture. Add the eggs one at a time together with a tablespoon of flour, beating well between each addition. Add the milk and a little flour, stir then beat. Stir in the fruit, grated rind and the remainder of the flour. Put the mixture into a lined round 7" tin and bake in a moderate oven for 1¼ hrs, or until cooked.

Cover with greaseproof paper when sufficiently brown on top. $180^{\circ}\,\text{C}$ (350°F), Gas Mark 4, middle shelf.

TIPS

 When exhibiting preserves and liqueurs, indicate the full date made on label and make sure jars and bottles are clean and free of finger marks.
 Do not use lids with advertising on i.e. Tiptree Jams.
 Screw tops are permissible for jams and essential for pickles.

Victoria Sandwich

The jam filling should be either raspberry (traditionally) or strawberry. The top should be lightly sprinkled with caster sugar. Each half should be cooled base down on the cooling rack to avoid grid marks.
